## Executive Director’s Note of April, 2021 .....

Dear Friends:

WE ARE STILL HERE FOR YOU! This past year was a full on roller-coaster ride for most of us. Bereaved Families of Ontario - Durham Region has and will always remain steadfastly committed to serving our community through zoom drop-ins, telephone one on ones, emails, our BFO-D Facebook page and our website updates.

While facing the “red zone” restrictions just weeks ago, we commenced training for the maximum allowable eight new facilitators. Unfortunately this training had to be halted, but will be continued just as soon as provincial restrictions are relaxed. Our Children’s Group scheduled to start in mid-April was additionally postponed, along with a planned Dad’s Group. 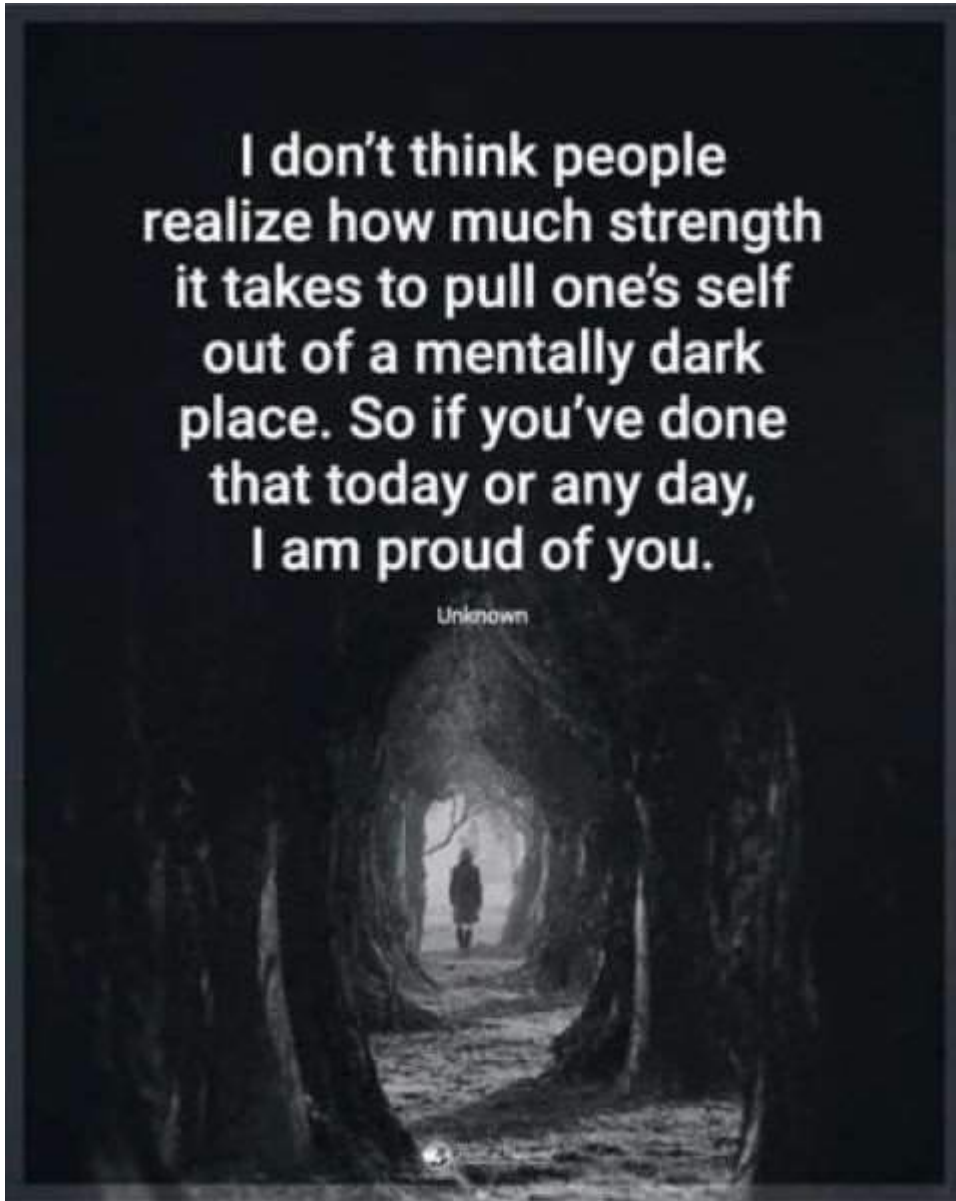

## Zoom Mini Mothers' Retreat

The door to the offices of Bereaved Families is closed for now, as are those of the Villa St. Joseph, location of our annual Bereaved Mothers' Retreat; however, at Jane Carter's suggestion, we were able to provide a virtual 'retreat' meeting of support to past retreat participants through Zoom. The first was held on the evening of Monday, March 8th, 2021 and centered on the theme of 'Missing Connections' and the second on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 when we shared our grief around the theme of 'Spring: a season in the Garden of Grief.' Although it can never replace the close companionship that evolves through physical sharing of space, the meetings began with reaching out to each other through hand actions to music.

Susan Hendricks and Joyce MacIntyre are happy to create programs for other groups of bereaved moms. These two-hour meetings include gathering rituals, candle lighting in memory of our children, a brief check-in and sharing with a specific theme as our 'jump-off', sharing around our virtual program where you can join other bereaved mothers. Brief prepared prayers, short meditations and candle lighting rituals start off the evening where mothers are invited to share with each other in a safe environment. A short closing ritual ends the evening. There is no charge and all you will need is access to the Zoom app, a pen, paper and candle. The short program and information with any extra needs will be sent to you shortly before meeting. The Zoom link will be forwarded to you on the day of the retreat by the BFO Office.

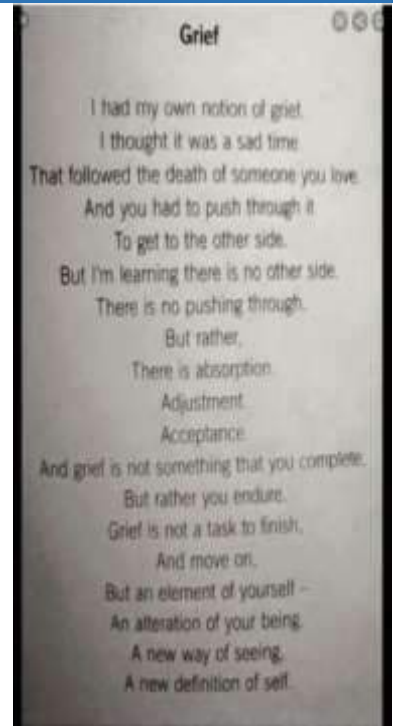
