The Board of Directors' Corner

The challenges of Covid -19

On March 17th BFO Durham board of directors had to make the difficult decision to close the office and suspend all in person programs. Fortunately, a children's support group had just finished but two mother's groups and a father's group, and an infant loss group had to stop midway. We were able to continue all our scheduled drop in's online using Zoom. Jane remained on duty in the office and also working from home to answer calls and manage any other affairs.

Upcoming fundraisers also had to be cancelled. April's planned "Spring Fling" dinner dance was postponed to October but is now cancelled altogether as it will not be possible to hold it at that time either. The Lauren Wright softball tournament and the Bike, Blade and Board for Blake fundraiser also had to be cancelled. The "Ride to Remember" switched to an online silent auction and donation appeal, the actual motorbike ride was cancelled. As you can imagine, this caused a major drop in expected income. Some of our members raised funds by making masks and holding birthday fundraisers on Facebook. Normally we do not receive any government funding but we did qualify for the covid-19 wage support subsidy. This has helped to offset some of the lost revenue.

The early months of shutdown were very difficult for our members, especially newly bereaved parents who were desperate to come to the office and meet in person with Jane or one of our facilitators. Of course, we had to follow the public health guidelines. As soon as each phase of loosening restrictions went into effect, we put in place our Covid-19 protocols to allow people back into the office. Eventually, with phase 3, we were able to continue our previously suspended groups and start new ones for those parents and children on our waiting list.

It is not the ideal format for group work but at least everyone is together in person. The beautiful cozy group rooms can only be used for 1 on 1 meetings while social distancing rules are in effect. We can now also hold in person drop in's and we continue to hold virtual ones via Zoom.

The next fundraiser and support program is the Angels' Tree of Light. We had hoped to make this year's event extra special as it will be our 25th year of having a memorial tree. Beautiful, silver coloured angels will adorn the tree this year. Sadly, we will not be able to hold the event at the Durham District school board headquarters. With inside social gatherings limited to a maximum of only 50 persons we have decided to film the event without a live audience. More details are available in this newsletter. 'Danielle's gift bags'



My name is Karen Beckett and I lost my beautiful daughter, Danielle, suddenly and tragically August 24, 2014, exactly one week before her 25th birthday. In that instant my life as I knew it would never be the same. My heart shattered into a million pieces and I became a bereaved mother.

As any mom who has lost a child can tell you, a bereaved mother walks one of the hardest, most heartbreaking roads anyone will ever have to walk. It is one full of unimaginable loss and such an indescribable grief. A bereaved mother may sometimes find it difficult to take care of herself, especially in the early days when her grief is so raw. She can experience incredible anxiety, sleeplessness, and a lack of energy. This I know all too well.

Six months after I lost Danielle, I attended a "mothers' group" offered at BFO and it truly was a turning point for me in my grief. I made lifelong friends that are still a big support to me now and I know they always will be. There is a sisterhood among bereaved mothers and in some small way I wanted to try and help my sisters in grief.

"Even as I rocked on my knees, howling I detected soft breathing behind the roaring. I leaned in, listened. It was the murmuring of ten million mothers, backward and forward in time and right now, who had lost children. They were lifting me, holding me. They had woven a net of their broken hearts, and they were keeping me safe there. I realized that one day I would take my rightful place as a link in this web, and I would hold my sister-mothers when their children died. For now my only task was to grieve and be cradled in their love."

In Danielle's memory, I will be donating gift bags full of various comfort and self-care items to moms who are attending a "mothers' group" for the very first time. The bags will feature the book *You Are The Mother Of All Mothers*, a beautiful gift book to uplift the hearts and souls of bereaved mothers, no matter the age or cause of death, no matter the story. This year I am happy to announce I will be collaborating with a fellow bereaved mama and owner of Spirit Wear Jewelry, a lovely shop on Etsy, who will make beautiful hand crafted bracelets. They will be designed with chakra beads to help bring balance and grounding as well as essential oil diffusing beads. I will also include some lavender oil for the relaxing benefits from this essential oil.

I have donated over a hundred bags to mamas over the last few years. I have received incredibly positive feedback from my family and friends. I had so many people generously give money towards the costs of the bags. Everyone wanted to help, not only because they love Danielle and they wanted to support me, but because they have seen what I go through on a daily basis and they also wanted to do something to help the moms who are grieving so profoundly. I am so grateful to be able to give these gifts to the moms who need them the most. As I put each bag together, I think of my beautiful daughter and I hoped she is smiling as she dances among the butterflies.

Bereaved Families of Ontario - Durham Region. 1 Million Meter Row Challenge.

Around the middle of July this year, BFO Durham member Eric Davidson decided he needed to make some life changes, and hopefully at the same time, be able to raise some much needed funds to benefit BFO-D. He vowed to start living a fitter, healthier life, and announced his decision on Facebook

"I am performing a 1 million meter row challenge to raise money for BFO – Durham, to be completed by 24th December 2020 (Approx. 22 weeks) averaging 45,000 meters (42,195 is a marathon) per week to meet this challenge. I started 8 weeks ago and I am currently at 458,102 meters (updated as 13-Sep). As FB only allow charity challenges for 3 month, I will not be putting up a donate button till 1st Oct.

BFO – Durham supports hundreds of families struggling to cope with the loss of a loved one, without any government support. If you could sponsor me for \$1, \$2, \$10 or more per 100,000 meters it would be greatly appreciated and 100% of all money raised will be going to a great cause.

How to set up for a Free ZOOM Meeting

ZOOM is VERY easy to use

For our BFO meetings, there will be a link provided that you just click and voila you are there. Make sure you have your audio on (so everyone can hear you), you do NOT have to connect a video if you don't want to be seen – but let's face it... we want to see and hear each other during this stressful time.

Create your FREE account: https://zoom.us/freesignup/

Do you need an account to use Zoom?

A Zoom account is not required if you are strictly joining Zoom Meetings as a participant. If someone invites you to their meeting, you can join as a participant without creating an account. However, if the host has restricted joining meetings using authentication profiles, then the participant will need a Zoom account to access the meeting

A Zoom account is only required if you need to create your own meetings and send invitations to participants. Having a Zoom account allows you to create your own <u>Instant Meetings or Schedule Meetings</u>. An account also allows you to access your personal settings, where you can <u>update your profile</u> or <u>upgrade your plan</u> at any time.

How do I signup for Zoom?

You can sign up for a free Zoom account at zoom.us/signup.

How much does Zoom cost?

A basic Zoom license is free. Learn more about available Zoom plans and pricing.

Joining a Meeting

How do I join a Zoom meeting?

You can join a meeting by clicking the <u>meeting link</u> or going to <u>join.zoom.us</u> and entering in the meeting ID. <u>Learn more</u> about joining a meeting.

How do I join computer/device audio?

On most devices, you can join computer/device audio by clicking Join Audio, Join with Computer Audio, or Audio to access the audio settings. <u>Learn more about connecting your audio.</u>

Can I Use Bluetooth Headset?

Yes, as long as the Bluetooth device is compatible with the computer or mobile device that you are using.

Do I have to have a webcam to join on Zoom?

While you are not required to have a webcam to join a Zoom Meeting or Webinar, you will not be able to transmit video of yourself. You will continue to be able to listen and speak during the meeting, share your screen, and view the webcam video of other participants.

Adult (18+) Sibling Loss

Hello Everyone,

I wanted to take the time to introduce myself to you all and reach out to all other siblings who may be looking for support and guidance. I facilitate the adult sibling loss (18+) drop-ins.

Throughout my grief journey, the biggest issue I noticed was to try and find a connection and network with other surviving siblings who would know exactly how I felt after losing my youngest sister. I didn't like the feeling of being alone and not having someone I could reach out to and talk about different topics of grief with a sibling loss. When I first found BFO, there was a drop-in group for sibling loss, however, it would be a few months apart, but to me, it didn't matter because it still gave me a chance to hopefully meet others and be able to chat for that 2-hours, about anything that was bothering me at the time. Topics such as; birthdays, anniversaries, my story, my relationship with other family members, where I saw my future going, etc.


These were the reasons why I knew when I felt ready, I wanted to give back to BFO and support other adult siblings and become a facilitator to provide my experience in grief and what strategies and tactics I've used to overcome difficulties.

During this quarantine time, there is a virtual zoom drop-in style meeting(2nd Tuesday of each month 7pm-9pm). Once the restrictions have lifted, there will be a regular monthly in-person drop-in style meeting.

As a facilitator, I am always available to do one-on-one sessions as well for those who may want to start with something more intimate. I hope that during these times, you stay healthy and safe and know that here at BFO, we are a family, and you are not alone.




IMPORTANT NOTE TO ALL MEMBERS
