Marian will be very much missed, a voice of calm and wisdom for the board ever since it was formed. The countless hours Marian gave to BFO as co-founder, facilitator, treasurer and bookkeeper were a tremendous support to BFO Durham and all its members for almost 30yrs

On behalf of the board, I want to wish Marian all the best and we hope to still see her at our events

The following article is a lovely tribute to Marian written by Susan Hendricks

MARIAN REHR

Because she is so self-effacing and humbly driven, it is very difficult to describe Marian Rehr and all that she has done for BFO – Durham. She truly understands that service is not about making herself important but about supporting and helping the other in spite of her own needs or wants – otherwise she would not have been able to support BFO as Co-Founder and Treasurer for the past thirty years! Marian's level of commitment demonstrates her continuing love for her son, Martin, who died at Easter in 1990.

Marian and I met with two other bereaved mothers who lived in Durham but were part of the Metro Toronto BFO organization – Priscilla Butler and Emily Parker – and together we co-founded the Durham Chapter in late 1993. The others would leave fairly soon, first Priscilla who moved away and a year or so later, Emily. Marian and I remained as the bones of the organization, holding it up and watching it become a living entity with flesh of its own, joined later by a Board of Directors. Trained by Toronto as facilitators, she and I led the first groups, usually held in church meeting rooms whose space was donated to the fledgling BFO. Many in those first groups have remained friends and gone on to serve the organization as volunteers, facilitators, Board members and even Executive Directors

Marian's calming presence and sense of wellbeing, whether or not she was having a good or bad day, reassured these bereaved parents that there can be a life following the death of a child, particularly if it is lived within the continuing spiritual presence of our dear ones. Quite apart from her quiet presence, we cannot forget her lovely giggle, which has not been lost to grief and sorrow.

As a co-facilitator with Marian, I was blessed by her support but also by her wonderful memory and skills of observation. In those days we followed the Toronto format, noting where everyone sat, grief issues that were observed. I would note down the seating arrangement on my coffee cup: Marian didn't need to. She had almost a photographic and auditory memory and was able to recall most details of the meeting without any reminders. Rosemary Tremblay Davis, a member of that first group has said, "When I think of Marian, I think of her quiet presence always there but in the background, gently offering her wisdom and support to all of us. Maybe like the wind beneath our wings." And Janice Ainsley, again of that first group experience, "I remember Marian as a kind and gentle soul dealing with loss as we all were. Both you and Marian were there to help us cope during our difficult times and we rejoiced in each other's good times welcoming new family members."

Marian has been that for me and more and quite likely for everyone she meets. I think of all the Walkathons where Marian would collect all the pledges. I think of the two Garage Sales we held in the early days where she did the same amidst the fun of balloons and barbeque. I think of and admire her stoic attitude that has allowed her to bear so many hurts and issues associated with grief without ever complaining publicly.

Marian is someone whose presence we take for granted: she has always been there for us. She is the ultimate volunteer, one who in giving has discovered and become more deeply embedded in her own goodness. I hope we have given back to her in equal proportion the gifts that she has given to us.






