Lauren Wright Slo-Pitch Tournament 2023

The 4th Annual Lauren Wright Co-Ed Slo-Pitch tournament was held on Sunday June 11, 2023 in memory of our daughter Lauren who we lost on May 28, 2014 to suicide.

Lauren was an avid softball and hockey player, playing both sports at the rep level. It just seemed natural to us to start this tournament a few years ago in Lauren's memory to help out important charities in our community and as a bonus it allows us a way to reconnect with our friends, family, and Lauren's friends. This year we were finally able to get back to the tournament after a break due to Covid.

Funds raised by the tournament benefit two charities: Bereaved Families Ontario (Durham Region) and Kid's Help Phone. These two charities are both extremely important in our community. BFO was instrumental in helping us get through the grief of losing Lauren and Kid's Help Phone is crucial in our community to help kids (and they now help adults as well, there is no age limit) who are struggling, unfortunately more important now than ever.

The last tournament, prior to Covid, we hosted 11 teams. Some were put together by friends, family and co-workers specifically for the tournament along with some teams that play weekly in local leagues. That was our best year financially up to that date, raising \$5274.29.

Well, we just blew that away! We only had 5 teams this year but due to tremendous response via cash and product donations from the local business community along with the players and many spectators jumping on the raffle table and silent auction table we were able to raise a whopping \$7413.08 to divide between the two charities.

A big thank you to everyone that attended and we hope to see you out again next year!

To Lorraine Kingsley from your Angel Sisters;

We met Lorraine during woman's group at BFOD in April 2016. Lorraine had lost her son James in 2015. We were all hurting and lost, but somehow, we found strength in each other. Though our women's group facilitated by BFO formally ended in 2016 we have been getting together regularly ever since, talking about our kids, our lives and just helping each other along the way.

We (eight of us) call our group the Angel Mom's and sisters.

Unfortunately, in April of 2022 Lorraine was diagnosed with cancer and was taken by the disease this May (2023) leaving a hole in our group. Every person in a group has different qualities and Lorraine was the quiet one, with a strong internal will, soft spoken, a good listener and a lovely unique laugh!.

Since they were born, Lorraine has had a deep love for her 3 children. She was a single parent and carried the extra weight of two children with serious health issues on her own. Consistent visits to Toronto Sick Kids Hospital was a regular occurrence.

Lorraine was very dedicated to her children and she worked tirelessly to provide for them as best she could in every area of their lives. This became wholly apparent when we heard the stories of them growing up. She included them in almost all of her adventures and tried her best to support them. She was a hard working mom; catching a bus/train into Toronto at 4 am, to get to Billy Bishop Airport where she was a shuttle bus driver. It is quite a picture to imagine the very petite Lorraine deftly moving a large shuttle bus through the downtown Toronto traffic all day, and yet she did it admirably. This past year she was so proud of her oldest son Rob and was thrilled at his recent marriage! Lorraine had a big heart which included a love of animals. For Lorraine her cats were truly her babies as well.

Lorraine showed so much love for us "Angel Moms". She just loved our get togethers. At a cottage weekend she was so giddy taking many photos with her new selfie stick. That weekend especially her laugh was contagious. We were always impressed with Lorraine's ability to seek out her favourite celebrities when they were on any kind of promotional tour. She'd manage to get her photo taken with them and often an autograph as well. Perhaps these celebrity tours would attract many fans, but we will always think of it as uniquely Lorraine.

Dear Friends of BFO-Durham - This is the Story behind the Monkey Business Workshop

This endeavor is in memory of my son, Shane Reymes, who sadly passed away in April of 2022 at the young age of 46.

My son Shane was given a sock monkey for his first birthday by his Aunt. That monkey went everywhere with him throughout his life. Here is a picture of Shane as a small boy with his Aunt and his brand-new monkey.

As the years went by and after it being dragged around everywhere, it started to wear and fray so I had to re-cover it. With the assurance from me that his real monkey was underneath the new repair sock, he enjoyed years and years of continued friendship with his monkey. Even as an adult his monkey could always be found somewhere, such as on a



dresser or shelf or sometimes even on his bed.

So, this past Christmas I decided that I would start making monkeys in memory and in honour of Shane's beautiful life with ALL monies raised going to charity in his name. The specific charity for this part of the project will go to BFO-Durham.

I found BFO-D after my son passed away and participated in the Mother's group. The people at BFO-D are such wonderful people and the cause is so needed at a time when the suffering of profound grief is so unbearable. This is a small way that I can give back to those who helped me so much in those early days and who continue to do so today.

I have made a collection of 52 monkey styles that are available for sale. Each one is "one of a kind" however if what you choose has already been purchased, I will re-make any one of them to resemble, as closely as possible, to your choice including the fabrics and accessories. Special requests are available within reason. You can request the PDF catalogue by emailing or calling me directly.

So, may I encourage you to think about participating in this project by buying one or more monkeys? They are recommended for age 4+ and that includes adults! These monkeys would be perfect to give as gifts or to sit on your bookshelf, in your office or in another special place.

Here is a little information about each monkey:

- The monkeys and outfits are hand made in Canada by me (Marlene, Shane's Mom) and made with much love.

-Each monkey is approximately 18" – 22" in height depending on the design.

-each monkey has inserted into it, one rose quartz crystal to represent the monkey's heart. The rose quartz crystal is typically known as a healing crystal and is the stone of universal love. These rose quartz crystals come from a big collection of gemstones and crystals that belonged to Shane.

-to make ordering easier, each monkey has been named by immediate family and all have a special meaning to us. However, please feel free to re-name your monkey to whatever you would like once you receive it.

-all appendages are double, or triple sewn for secure attachment.

-the eyes are triple sewn and glued for secure attachment.

-each monkey is hand washable - lay flat to dry, as indicated on the sewn-on label.

-all proceeds from the sale of the monkeys will go to BFO-D. I am contributing the cost of all the material and my time to the cause.






"My Sister, Marie" A children's book on sibling loss


