2017 "THE ANGELS' TREE OF LIGHT"



On Thursday November 23rd BFO-Durham held its annual Angels' Tree of Light ceremony. A large crowd was in attendance. We updated our tree to a larger 12' model so our Angels have more room to spread their wings and we also changed the colour theme to "BFO" blue. Our new tree looked so beautiful with its white lights and over 600 ceramic angels. Each angel bore the name of a loved one sadly missed by their families and friends at the holiday season.

Jennifer Carter, on behalf of her mother, Jane Carter (BFO-Durham Executive Director) gave us a warm welcome speech and hosted the ceremony. With Jane by her side, recovering from a cold, Jennifer explained her mother was here with us working hard but her voice had already gone on vacation.

Opening remarks were given by Rev. Maureen McLellan. Her gentle words gave advice, encouragement and support to the audience, along with her own story of grieving. The dedication was given by Andrea Onley, with husband Jonathan and baby son, by her side. Andrea spoke of her own family's holiday experience after the loss of their daughter Sarah. Then, on behalf of all present, she dedicated each angel on the tree in memory of all our loved ones. Rocco Granato and Kelly Fitzpatrick had the honour of lighting our tree this year, in memory of their daughter, Racquel. As the lights in the auditorium dimmed, only the tree shone in the darkness. We had a moment of silence for our own thoughts. As the lights gently came back on, we were treated to a beautiful rendition of Michael Jackson's "*You Are Not Alone*", performed by Kalista Wilson. This was followed by a special song, written and performed by Jonathan Onley, for his daughter Sarah, called "*Won't Forget Your Face*". During the song, Jonathan invited us all to say the name of our loved one. It was a very moving moment. Both singers received much deserved loud applause from the audience. Finally, the ceremony concluded with Linda Watson and Karen Beckett leading us all in a responsive reading.

After the ceremony, there was an opportunity to mingle and share stories over light refreshments.
