2018 MOTHERS' RETREAT A "RESOUNDING SUCCESS"



"HEARTS OF STONE, HEARTS OF LOVE" brought mothers to the Villa St. Joseph this past March to celebrate and honour their child's memory. but also examine a grief journey that is multi-faceted, pushing us in one direction while at other times, pulling us toward another. This is the paradox of mourning the loss of a child: wanting to hold on to what we know, yet hoping to move into an unknown life that looms ahead of grief.

Mothers who attended reported that this was the best retreat yet though we are unsure why that was. Perhaps it was that all sessions were more experiential than in the past? Mothers opened small envelopes to find coins minted in the same year as their child and holding them as a talisman, reflected on the duality of grief. They chose stones and painted words and symbols of feelings, both positive and 'negative' that represent where they are today. Could it be that there was greater focus on their child with the group being divided into two to allow each mother more time to talk about their child? Or that there were two meditations instead of one? Whatever it was, participants left feeling uplifted, enriched and more in touch with their child and each other than ever before.



The Sisters of St. Joseph have kindly extended their hospitality for two retreats next May to ensure that all who wish to attend are able to be accommodated. Next year's 'Wings of Hope' in May celebrates the 20th Anniversary of our retreats. Plan on attending and fly with your child toward Life.
