BIKE, BLADE OR BOARD FOR BLAKE 2016

Bike, Blade or Board for Blake is an event in memory of our eighteen year old son, Blake Garvey, who we lost on February 21st 2013 to the disease of Addiction. Blake suffered with anxiety and depression and turned to drugs to suppress the effects of these mental health issues. The pledges solicited and collected by participants help to fund programs offered through Durham Mental Health Services and Bereaved Families of Ontario-Durham Region.

The event is intended to help raise awareness of mental health and addiction in our community. It is also an opportunity to raise awareness of the support and services available at Bereaved Families of Ontario - Durham Region. Donations will go to each of these organizations. There will be a BBQ, guest speakers and many draws for prizes.

The event will be held on Saturday, October 1st at the waterfront trail in Bowmanville. All participants must register with their pledge sheets or purchase a ticket for \$25.00 and will be entered into the draws for prizes.
