On November 26, 2015 BFO-Durham held their 20th anniversary annual memorial service "The Angels' Tree of Light" at the Durham District School Board premises. As in past years, hundreds of people attended the service in memory of their loved one.

The tree was a moving sight, decorated with hundreds of angels with silver ribbons attached. Every angel represented a deceased child, relative or friend.

Sharon Sears welcomed everyone and Randy Gill was very sensitive in his opening remarks.

Marian Rehr touched on every one's grief in her dedication and assured people they could still celebrate the holidays, although some changes may be necessary.

The tree was lit by young Wesley, Braelyn and their mother Lisa Fogg. After a moment of silence, special songs were performed by Lauren Sears and Sabrina Moreino.

The memorial portion of the service was closed with a Responsive Reading, given by Anita Fellows and her friend, Margaret.

After the service, tables were set with trays of refreshments and many people took advantage of the opportunity to socialize with friends and other bereaved families they have met through our organization.



INSPIRATIONAL CORNER BY JOYCE SCHNEIDER



2016 MOTHER'S RETREAT

The BFO Mothers' Retreat



Mindfulness is the aware, balanced acceptance of the present experience. It is opening to or receiving the present moment, pleasant or unpleasant, just as it is, without either clinging to it or rejecting it. – Sylvia Boorstein

Remembering the past and imagining a future without our children makes the present experience of grief a searingly painful experience. And yet it is only by entering the pain of the present moment that we are transformed and learn to live again.

Running from Friday evening at 7 pm until just after lunch on Sunday, the retreat is designed to deepen our awareness of how the loss of our children has impacted our lives as women and mothers. This weekend of prayer, candle lighting in memory of our children, meditation, workshops and group discussion sessions focuses on our personal, psychological and spiritual growth. We each bring our own unique experience to the weekend to make it one of special sharing and enrichment.

The Bereaved Mothers' Retreat weekend is part of BFO's aftercare programming for those who have already completed a support group. Enhanced by the peace and quiet of the Villa St. Joseph and its welcoming Sisters, this is a weekend where all may enter the quiet and holy space within and reconnect with the Seed of Life that rests in all of Creation.

Registration is limited. Previous attendance within a group bereavement session is essential for you to benefit from the retreat experience as it is an intensive yet fulfilling and 'fun' weekend. Participants must have passed a three year anniversary. Priority is given to those who meet these criteria and have never attended the retreat before. Your cheques will be returned to you if we are not able to include you in this year's program.

What do I bring with me?

- Bedding and towels are provided.

- displayed during our prayer services
 A journal and pen if you are a notetaker


